Dear Mr. Weber:

This letter is written in follow-up to a construction storm water inspection I conducted at US Route 23 and Peachblow-Winter Road in Delaware, Ohio on June 23, 2010. The purpose of the inspection was to evaluate compliance with the General Storm Water Permit Associated with Construction Activities. During the inspection, I noted the following issues associated with construction activities at this site:

Sediment and Erosion Control:

- The inlet protection directly south of the Career Center is not properly constructed. Please ensure that lateral supports are implemented.
- The southern slope of the tributary to the Olentangy located on the northern end of the project protected immediately.
- Please ensure that all barren areas which remain idle in excess of 21 days are adequately protected.

Post Construction:

- I have had the opportunity to evaluate alternatives to the quantity issue for the northern storm water outfall based on my conversation with ODOT Central Office, the quantity issue still remains. I will be evaluating alternatives in the future. Please contact me upon receipt to set up meetings to resolve this issue.
