This letter is written in follow-up to a construction storm water inspection I conducted at 8579 & 8591 Summit Road Reynoldsburg, Ohio 43068 on June 28, 2010 and July 1, 2010. The purpose of the inspection was to evaluate compliance with the General Storm Water Permit Associated with Construction Activities. During the inspection, I noted the following issues associated with construction activities at this site:

**Sediment and Erosion Control:**

- Per request, I evaluated the erosion control and vegetative cover associated with the recently constructed ball fields east of the tributary to the south fork of the Licking River.
- Vegetative is established sufficiently to control erosion. As a result, the sediment controls associated with this area may be removed.
