Dear Mr. Sisto:

This letter is written in follow-up to a construction storm water inspection I conducted at Bedford Landfill located in Gahanna, Ohio on April 29, 2010. The purpose of the inspection was to evaluate your compliance with the General Storm Water Permit Associated with Construction Activities. During the inspection, I noted the following:

Sediment and Erosion Controls:

- The site was subject to stabilization efforts prior to the winter months. Approximately 50 to 60 percent of the site has been stabilized.
- Efforts must continue to stabilize the remainder of the site to ensure compliance with the General Permit. All remaining barren areas which are idle in excess of 21 days must be protected from erosion. Based on my observations, this appears to be the remainder of the site. Corrective measures to stabilize the entire site are expected within seven days from receipt of this letter.
- The site must be inspected and every seven days and within 24 hours of a precipitation event equal to or greater than 0.5 inches. All deficiencies must be logged and repaired in accordance with General Permit conditions. Generally deficiencies must be corrected within three days of discovery. The inspection logs must be maintained onsite available for review.

Re: Storm Water Inspection at Bedford II

Dear Mr. Geiger:

This letter is written regarding the storm water inspection I conducted at Bedford II, located in Gahanna, Ohio on April 29, 2010. The Agency understands that these construction activities are currently covered under the General Storm Water Permit Associated with Construction Activities. Based on the site inspection and the General Storm Water Permit, the following items were noted:

Sediment and Erosion Controls:

- Additional measures must be implemented to ensure the entire site is directed to the impoundment intended for sediment control. This specifically applies to the southern boundary of the site.
- The outlet structure (skimmer) to the sediment pond was damaged and not functioning as intended during my inspection. **Corrective measures are expected within three days from receipt of this letter.**
- Be aware the General Permit states that all barren areas which remain idle in excess of 21 days must be protected from erosion within seven days of the last earth disturbing activities. In addition, erosion protection must be implemented for all areas of final grade within seven (7) days.

Maintenance Inspections:

- The General Permit requires the permittee to conduct self inspections of the site every seven days or within 24 hours of a precipitation event equal to or greater than 0.5 inches. Logs of all inspections must be available for review upon request. Logs must include date of inspection, authorized representative, all deficiencies, and the date corrective actions were implemented. The logs must also include dates of earth disturbing activities to ensure the permanent and temporary stabilization requirements are not violated.
