Sediment and Erosion Controls:


- The majority of Phase two was protected with a temporary cover in preparation for the upcoming winter months.
- The temporary crossing associated with Chinney Creek is removed and the area stabilized. This area may require additional erosion control based on special conditions imposed during the planning process. The area will continued to be monitored for effective erosion control. (see photo)
- Please finalize the winter stabilization efforts. I noted additional barren areas in the area west of Chinney Creek and the location where Phase 2 merges into Phase 1.
