
A review of the Ohio EPA Surface Water Information Management System (SWIMS) indicates that no monthly operating reports have been recorded for the above referenced facility. You and I had discussed this matter by telephone on January, 23, 2007. At that time you indicated that you would contact your wastewater treatment plant operator to arrange for reports submittal.

Please be advised that failure to comply with effluent limitations or to satisfy monitoring or reporting requirements of your NPDES permit may be cause for enforcement action pursuant to the Ohio Revised Code Chapter 6111.

Please inform me, in writing, within ten days of receipt of this notification as to the reasons for the above referenced violations, as well as a description of the actions taken or proposed to prevent any further violations. Your response should include dates, either actual or proposed, for completion of the actions. Please include in your response the name and telephone number of the Class I Wastewater Treatment Plant Operator in responsible charge of your wastewater treatment plant.
