Dear Mr. Tucker:

On March 12, 2012, I conducted a site investigation of property you own in the Village of Clarington. I observed a significant amount of solid waste at property you own on Monroe Drive.

The Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) and Ohio Revised Code (ORC) prohibit open dumping of solid waste. Specifically,

ORC 3734.03 - No person shall dispose of solid wastes by open dumping or open burning.

OAC 3745-27-05(C) - No person shall conduct, permit, or allow open dumping. In the event that open dumping is occurring or has occurred at a property, the person responsible for the open dumping, the owner of the property, or the person who allows or allowed open dumping to occur, shall promptly remove and dispose or otherwise manage the solid waste in accordance with Chapter 3734. of the Revised Code, and shall submit verification that the solid waste has been properly managed.

In addition the illegal disposal of demolition debris is a violation of OAC Rule 3745-400-04 (B).

Please contact me at 740/380-5219 to advise me of your intentions for the waste material on your property. A failure to comply with Ohio law could result in escalated enforcement by the State of Ohio. Thank you for your attention to this matter.
