Dear Mr. Scott:

This letter confirms my visit to your residence at 3400-B State Route 23, Delaware wherein I observed that you have been open burning in violation of Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) 3745-19-04(A). These actions are subject to fines and penalties.

Specifically, at 3400-B State Route 23, Delaware, you have been open burning furniture, fiberglass, miscellaneous plastic materials and box springs. Additionally, you have been open burning landscape waste within 1,000 feet from the nearest inhabited building off said premises.

This letter is not a final action of the Director of the Ohio EPA and is intended only as a notification of a violation of the Ohio environmental laws and regulations. It does not preclude Ohio EPA or any other governmental entity from further enforcement action.
