This letter acknowledges receipt of your e-mail correspondence on March 19, 2012 and March 26, 2012 responding to Ohio EPA's Notice of Violation (NOV) letter dated March 13, 2012.

My review of the documentation provided by this correspondence, which includes a current weekly container inspection log completed for three weeks and Aircraft Plating's procedures for obtaining, tracking and documenting RCRA training events, indicates that Aircraft Plating has adequately demonstrated abatement of the following violations from the February 29, 2012 inspection cited in my letter of March 13, 2012, specifically:

1. **OAC rule 3745-65-16(C) – Annual review of initial training.**
OAC rule 3745-65-16(D)(4) – Must maintain training program records.
OAC rule 3745-65-16(E) – Training records must be kept
2. **OAC Rule 3745- 66-74 Weekly Inspections of Hazardous Waste Containers**
