Dear Public Water System Owner:

I have received additional results of Total Haloacetic Acids (HAA5) collected during the Fourth Quarter of 2011 that were not previously submitted by your contract laboratory. These additional results have reduced your running annual average for this time period and you are now under the maximum contaminant level (MCL) for HAA5. Therefore, the violation of exceeding the MCL for HAA5 issued on March 2, 2012 is rescinded, and the City of Barberton will not be required to issue public notice as outlined in the notice of violation.

In order to remain in compliance, you must continue to monitor for all chemical parameters as indicated on your most recent monitoring schedule.
