Re: ILLEGAL OPEN BURNING MCKINLEY TOWNSHIP

The Canton City Health Department, Air Pollution Control Division (APCD) represents the Ohio EPA in air quality matters within Stark County. As such, APCD employees have the authority to investigate and enforce Ohio EPA (OEPA) air pollution regulations.

On Thursday, November 10, 2011 at 1059 hrs, Engine 2 responded to your address for unauthorized burning. Found occupant H. Smith burning leaves. Crew extinguished fire, advised of city's open burning policy.

Please be advised that burning for waste disposal is also prohibited by the Ohio Administrative Code 3745-19-03. No further enforcement is planned at this time, but future occurrences could result in monetary fines.

By copy of this letter to 7th Street Properties LLC, they are advised that property owners can be held liable for offenses committed by tenants.
