Dear Mr. Esler:

On March 2, 2012, I inspected Tallmadge Service Center (Tallmadge) located at 210 Osceola Avenue, Tallmadge, Ohio. I have received your April 4, 2012 letter which responded to my inspection letter. As outlined below, Tallmadge has documented a correction of the violations found during the inspection.

1. OAC Rule 3745-52-11 – Hazardous waste determination.

Your letter states that you have contracted with Heritage-Crystal Clean to remove any waste fluorescent and mercury vapor lamps. This documents your correction of this violation.

Tallmadge also violated this rule by shipping used parts cleaner solvent to Heritage-Crystal Clean in Broadview Heights, Ohio, without determining whether it is a hazardous waste. I have received the Material Safety Data Sheet for this solvent from Ricky Koehler of Heritage-Crystal Clean. It shows that, unless certain hazardous materials are added to this solvent during use, this waste solvent would not be a hazardous waste. This documents the correction of this part of this violation.

You sent me the Material Safety Data Sheet for the Digest Aid that I saw in a drum stored in Building 3-9. It indicates that if it is a waste, then it would be a hazardous waste. Your letters state that this is material that Tallmadge will use and, therefore, is not a waste.

I saw an area outside with black material on the ground. I was told this is extra asphalt emulsion which is used for chip and seal road work and that the liquid seen was from rain water. Your letter and the enclosed photos document the cleanup and disposal of this material and, therefore, the correction of this violation.
