Dear Mr. Inman:

The Calvary United Baptist Church public water system has violated Ohio's safe drinking water laws. Specifically, Calvary United Baptist Church has failed to monitor for total coliform bacteria and nitrate, in accordance with Ohio Administrative Code 3745-81-21(A)(2)(a) and Ohio Administrative Code Rule 3745-81-23(B), respectively. Calvary United Baptist Church has not notified the public of these violations or submitted verification of these public notices to the Ohio EPA.

Owners or operators of public water systems that fail to comply with Ohio's safe drinking water laws and regulations are subject to civil penalties of up to \$25,000 per day per violation under Ohio Revised Code Section 6109.33.

To resolve your drinking water violations, remain in compliance and avoid possible legal action that could include civil penalties, it is agreed that Calvary United Baptist Church will:

1. Within thirty (30) days, post public notices for past violations for the failure to monitor for nitrates and total coliform for no less than seven (7) days in accordance with OAC Rule 3745-81-32. Send the public notices and verification forms to Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (EPA), Southwest District Office (SWDO), Division of Drinking and Ground Waters, Attn: Dave Secor, 401 East Fifth Street, Dayton, Ohio 45402.
2. Monitor for total coliform with one sample per calendar quarter from the distribution system and perform any required repeat monitoring, in accordance with OAC Rule 3745-81-21.

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3. Comply with the monitoring and reporting requirements in accordance with the 2009 and all future chemical monitoring schedules.
4. Contract with a certified laboratory to collect and analyze the required samples for 12 months to help meet regulatory requirements and establish a routine of compliance. Within thirty (30) days of the effective date of this agreement, submit a copy of the completed contract to Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (EPA), Southwest District Office (SWDO), Division of Drinking and Ground Waters, Attn: Dave Secor, 401 East Fifth Street, Dayton, Ohio 45402.

Ohio EPA reserves its right to seek civil penalties pursuant to Revised Code 6109.33 for the violations described in this letter.
