Dear Mr. Durnbaugh:

The Players Sports Pub public water system (PWS) has violated Ohio's safe drinking water laws. Specifically, Players Sports Pub has failed to monitor for total coliform bacteria and nitrate, in accordance with Ohio Administrative Code 3745-81-21(A)(2)(a) and Ohio Administrative Code Rule 3745-81-23(B), respectively. Players Sports Pub has not notified the public of these violations or submitted verification of these public notices to the Ohio EPA. Players Sports Pub also installed an iron removal unit and softener without plan approval, does not have an approved backflow prevention device and has failed to properly connect the electrical conduit to the well cap.

**Owners or operators of public water systems that fail to comply with Ohio's safe drinking water laws and regulations are subject to civil penalties of up to \$25,000 per day per violation under Ohio Revised Code Section 6109.33.**

To resolve your drinking water violations, remain in compliance and avoid possible legal action that could include civil penalties, it is agreed that Players Sports Pub PWS will:

1. Within thirty (30) days, post public notices for past violations for the failure to monitor for nitrate, nitrite and total coliform for no less than seven (7) days in accordance with OAC Rule 3745-81-32. Send the public notices and verification forms to Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (EPA), Southwest District Office (SWDO), Division of Drinking and Ground Waters, Attn: Dave Secor, 401 East Fifth Street, Dayton, Ohio 45402.
2. Monitor for total coliform with one sample per calendar quarter from the distribution system and perform any required repeat monitoring, in accordance with OAC Rule 3745-81-21.

3. Comply with the monitoring and reporting requirements in accordance with the 2009 and all future chemical monitoring schedules.
4. Within sixty (60) days of the effective date of this agreement, submit as-built plans for the iron removal unit and softener to Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (EPA), Southwest District Office (SWDO), Division of Drinking and Ground Waters, Attn: Dave Secor, 401 East Fifth Street, Dayton, Ohio 45402. Respond to any comments on the plans within thirty (30) days from notification.
5. Within sixty (60) days of the effective date of this agreement, provide an air gap separation from the end of the discharge line from the water softener and the floor drain. Send notification of completion to Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (EPA), Southwest District Office (SWDO), Division of Drinking and Ground Waters, Attn: Dave Secor, 401 East Fifth Street, Dayton, Ohio 45402.
6. Within thirty (30) days of the effective date of this agreement, connect the electrical conduit to the well cap. Send notification of completion to Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (EPA), Southwest District Office (SWDO), Division of Drinking and Ground Waters, Attn: Dave Secor, 401 East Fifth Street, Dayton, Ohio 45402.
