Dear Mr. Kessler:

This letter is written in follow-up to a construction storm water inspection I conducted at Worthington Galena Road and Lazelle Road at I-71, Westerville, Ohio on December 28, 2010. The purpose of the inspection was to evaluate compliance with the General Storm Water Permit Associated with Construction Activities. During the inspection, the following items were noted

Sediment and erosion controls:

- I noted vast areas which were recently stabilized with seed and mulch. The mulch did not appear crimped. Please be aware in the event mulch blows off-site, an additional application is expected. I would advise implementing measures to secure the mulch cover to avoid this cost.
- The northern most leg of the project has not been protected from erosion. Corrective measures are expected within 7 days from receipt of this letter. .
