Dear Mr. Jones:

This letter is written in follow-up to a construction storm water inspection I conducted at Hard Road Improvements located in Columbus, Ohio on December 1, 2010. The purpose of the inspection was to evaluate compliance with the General Storm Water Permit Associated with Construction Activities. It appeared during the inspection that construction activity is completed for this site. A Notice of Termination will be required provided the following requirements are met:

**Sediment and Erosion Control:**

- The majority of the site has been seeded and mulched. Established vegetation is minimal in areas near State Route 315. Vegetation must be established sufficient to control erosion which is measured by a minimum vegetative density of 70%.
- A Notice of Termination (NOT) must be submitted once vegetation is established. The NOT form and filing instructions can be found at:
