Dear Mr. Dozer:

This letter is written regarding the storm water inspection I conducted, on November 22, 2010, of the construction activities at The Woods, located off State Route 188, in Lancaster, Ohio. The Agency understands that these construction activities are currently covered under the General Storm Water Permit Associated with Construction Activities. Based on the site inspection and the General Storm Water Permit, the following was observed or discussed at the site:

Sediment and Erosion Controls:

There did not appear to be any construction activity at the site. Most of the site was stabilized and no erosion was leaving the site. Please be aware that if construction activities commence that the General Permit mandates that all barren areas which remain idle areas in excess of 21 days be protected from erosion (i.e., seed and straw), within seven days from the last construction activity.

There were two or three very small areas that were not stabilized. It is recommended that these areas are stabilized in order to prevent run-off during the winter months. However, no sediment was eroding off-site from these areas at this time. I have included pictures of these areas.




