Dear Ms. Rumpke:

This letter is written in follow-up to a preliminary industrial storm water inspection I conducted at Columbus Recycling, located at 1191 Fields Avenue, Columbus, Ohio on November 4, 2010. The purpose of the inspection was to evaluate compliance with the General Storm Water Permit Associated with Industrial Activities. During the inspection, the following items were noted:

- The majority of the waste is located under roof. Please ensure proper housekeeping practices to minimize exposure to storm water.
- Please verify all drains located under roof are routed properly to a sanitary sewer.
- Large fuel tanks appeared doubled walled. Implementation for contained fueling pads should be considered.
- Please ensure all metal trash receptacles are covered.
- I noted wash water from trash receptacle cleaning was directed to an apparent separate storm sewer (see attached photos). Please ensure all wash water from equipment and/or vehicle washing is routed to a sanitary sewer with the permission of the city of Columbus.
