Dear Mr. Kerns:

This letter is written regarding two storm water inspections I conducted at Buffalo Wild Wings in Reynoldsburg, Ohio on July 29, 2011 and on August 2, 2011. The purpose of the inspection was to evaluate compliance with the General Storm Water Permit associated with Construction Activities. During the inspection, our staff noted the following issues associated with construction activities at this site:

**Sediment and Erosion Control:**

- The perimeter silt fence located on the west portion of the site fails to meet the intent of the General Storm Water Permit conditions. At the time of the inspection, I recommended that a diversion be established in the same area as the linear silt fence to direct all storm water from the site to a sediment basin intended for sediment control.
- Be aware the General Permit states that all barren areas which remain idle in excess of 21 days must be protected from erosion within seven days of the last earth disturbing activities. In addition, erosion protection must be implemented for all areas of final grade within seven (7) days.
