Dear Ms. Franz:

This letter is written regarding a storm water inspection conducted by Daelann Farnlacher and Greg Mann of the Ohio EPA at the TL-400 Greenhouse Pipeline Replacement Project, Section 1 located at 10235 Doty Road in Pickerington, Ohio on August 2, 2011. The purpose of the inspection was to evaluate compliance with the General Storm Water Permit associated with construction activities. During the inspection, our staff noted the following issues associated with construction activities at this site:

Sediment and Erosion Control:

- The sediment and erosion controls at this site are currently functioning properly. Please continue to monitor and ensure continued compliance with the General Storm Water Permit associated with construction activities.
- Be aware the General Permit states that all barren areas which remain idle in excess of 21 days must be protected from erosion within seven days of the last earth disturbing activities. In addition, erosion protection must be implemented for all areas of final grade within seven (7) days.

Post Construction Requirements:

The General Storm Water Permit requires specific post construction water quality treatment for all sites. Guidance regarding the post construction mandates can be found at:
