Dear Mr. Benson:

This letter is written regarding a storm water inspection conducted by Greg Mann and Lauren Burns of the Ohio EPA at Toxco located at 265 Quarry Road in Lancaster Ohio on August 1, 2011. The purpose of the inspection was to evaluate compliance with the General Storm Water Permit associated with construction activities. During the inspection, our staff noted the following issues associated with construction activities at this site:

Sediment and Erosion Control:

- During our inspection our staff noted a drainway cut to channel water from dewatering activities. The controls associated with the drain way were approaching design capacity in order to minimize erosion to the channel. Please continue to maintain a stabilized drain way as it exits the site to minimize erosive flows (See attached Figures).
- Our observations led us to believe that dewatering activities were approaching a violation of your General Permit based on the turbidity of the discharges as they left the south west corner of the site.
- Please implement monitoring protocols of dewatering activities to avoid potential violations as we will be frequently monitoring the site.
