This letter is written regarding a storm water inspection conducted by Greg Mann and Lauren Burns of the Ohio EPA at River Valley Mall in Lancaster, Ohio on August 1, 2011. The purpose of the inspection was to evaluate compliance with the General Storm Water Permit associated with construction activities. During the inspection, our staff noted the following issues associated with construction activities at this site:

Sediment and Erosion Control:

- Construction activities were observed between the southern side of the mall and the wetland area south of the complex. Please be aware as construction progresses, it will be necessary to employ sediment and erosion controls in order to minimize offsite sediment transfer into the wetland area (See Figure 1).

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
