Dear Mr. Ehrhart:

This letter is written regarding the storm water inspection that I conducted on July 26, 2011, at your facility located at 6120 South Meadows Drive, in Grove City, Ohio. There were no construction activities that had taken place yet at the proposed site. The agency understands that these construction activities are currently covered under the General Storm Water Permit Associated with Construction Activities. Please be aware that if construction activities commence that the General Permit mandates that all barren areas which remain idle areas in excess of 21 days be protected from erosion (i.e., seed and straw), within seven days from the last construction activity.

Please be aware that this facility is also required to seek industrial storm water permit coverage, from Ohio EPA in accordance with 40 CFR 122.26, authorizing storm water discharges or obtain a No exposure certification (NOE). The permit requires the development and implementation of a Storm Water Pollution Prevention Plan (SWPPP). The SWPPP mandates specific storm water practices, which minimize storm water contamination, associated with external operations or exposed materials.
