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**NOTICE OF VIOLATION – ACTION REQUIRED**

**Subject: Failure to Sample Source Water for Fecal Indicators (Total Coliform) as Required**

Highland County Water Company, Inc. is in violation of Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) 3745-81-42 for failure to comply with the Ground Water Rule monitoring requirements.

<b>Monitoring Period:</b>	June 2011
<b>Required Monitoring:</b>	6
<b>Sample Results Submitted:</b>	None

**ACTION REQUIRED:**

- To address the violation, return to compliance, and prevent enforcement action the required source water samples must be collected from each well. Failure to collect the required source water sample(s) may result in enforcement action by the Ohio EPA.** If source water (raw) samples were collected as required, submit the results to the appropriate Ohio EPA District Office as soon as possible. The monitoring violation would be rescinded and a reporting violation given for late submittal of the results. If raw water samples were not collected, they must still be collected and Ohio EPA must receive results to return to compliance.
- Notify the people served by this water system** using one or more of the methods and the timing as required by OAC, Rule 3745-81-32 to reach all persons served.

**Timing:** As soon as practical, but no later than one year after learning of the violation:

- Mail or other direct delivery to each customer; OR
- Annual Consumer Confidence Report provided it's distributed within one year after learning of the violation; and
- If necessary to reach all persons regularly served, use other notification methods such as newspaper publication, public posting or Internet posting;

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- Posted notices must remain in place as long as the violation or situation exists, but in no case less than seven days (even if the violation is resolved). The language in italics on the enclosed public notice is mandatory and must be included, as written. Do not make changes to the public notice without consulting with the Ohio EPA beforehand.

**3. Complete the enclosed Verification Form within 10 days of issuing the Public Notice** and mail it to Ohio EPA - SWDO. Include a copy of each notice distributed, published or posted.

# DRINKING WATER NOTICE

## Source Monitoring requirements were not met for Highland County Water Company, Inc. Monitoring Period: June 2011

Our water system recently failed to collect well water samples for fecal indicators following a routine total coliform positive result in our distribution system. Although this incident is not an emergency, as our customers, you have the right to know what happened and what we did to correct the situation.

### What Should I Do?

- *There is nothing you need to do at this time. You do not need to boil your water or take other corrective actions. If a situation arises where the water is no longer safe to drink, you will be notified within 24 hours. We will announce any emergencies on local radio and television stations.*

### What is being done?

Upon being notified of this violation, we are required to post this public notice to inform our customers. Highland County Water Company, Inc. will take steps to ensure that adequate monitoring will be performed in the future.

**PUBLIC NOTICE INSTRUCTIONS AND VERIFICATION FORM FOR  
COMMUNITY PUBLIC WATER SYSTEMS WITH TIER 3 VIOLATIONS**

The owner or operator of a community public water system with a Tier 3 violation or situation shall notify the persons served by the public water system as soon as practical but **no later than one year** after the system learns of the violation. At a minimum, community public water systems must issue the notice by **mail or other direct delivery**. Public notice issued by methods other than posting shall be repeated annually as long as the violation or situation persists.
