
Re: ILLEGAL OPEN BURNING IN CANTON TOWNSHIP

The Canton City Health Department, Air Pollution Control Division (APCD) represents the Ohio EPA in air quality matters within Stark County. As such, APCD employees have the authority to investigate and enforce Ohio EPA (OEPA) air pollution regulations.

On Friday, April 13, 2012 I was at your residence in response to a report of open burning. You had two fires of landscape waste which were small in nature and nearly burnt out. As we discussed, these fires were in violation of Ohio EPA regulation. You live in a restricted area and are permitted only recreational fires (See OAC 3745-19-03(B)(2)).

This Agency appreciates your cooperation in handling these fires and in conducting no further burning for waste disposal
