Dear Mr. Young:

On November 4, 2010, while investigating a complaint regarding blowing sawdust, I observed several wood working processes operating at Twin Oak Forest Products, Ltd. The operations included Roadways and Parking Areas, Log Debarking, Woodworking Processes, Sawdust Storage Pile(s), and Material Handling / Yard operations. The sawdust storage areas and material handling operations did not have adequate control measures. Twin Oak Forest Products, Ltd. has operated at this location over several years.

A review of our files indicated these sources have not obtained a Permit to Install/Operate (PTIO) in accordance with OAC 3745-31-02. The installation, construction, and operation of these sources without obtaining permits is in violation of OAC 3745-31-02.


Ohio EPA is requesting Twin Oak Forest Products, Ltd. submit PTIO applications for its operations, with a plan and schedule for implementing any needed improvements to control emissions presented in the applications, to the Ohio EPA Southeast District Office within 90 days of receipt of this letter.

Acceptance by the Ohio EPA of application(s) or other documents does not constitute a waiver of the Ohio EPA's authority to seek civil penalties as provided in section 3704.06 of the Ohio Revised Code. The determination to pursue or decline to pursue such penalties in this case will be made by the Ohio EPA at a later date.
