Dear Mr. Maloney:

On March 25, 2009, the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (Ohio EPA), Division of Hazardous Waste Management, received Crane Aerospace & Electronics - Lear Romec Division's (Lear Romec) response to the Agency's February 26, 2009 Notice of Violation letter (NOV). On March 13, 2009, Lear Romec facility representatives met with Ohio EPA to discuss the actions the facility has taken to come into compliance.

In response to NOV letter, Lear Romec hired a third party consultant to assess the facility's operations, implemented a waste management and minimization program, and re-evaluated all waste streams. As a result of these activities, the facility will segregate the following waste streams for appropriate management: used oil, spent solvent (calibrating fluid and agitene), mop water, and spent jet fuel. In addition, the spent lamps will be managed as a universal waste.

**Ohio EPA's review of this information reveals that Lear Romec has adequately demonstrated abatement of all violations discovered during the January 27, 2009 inspection.**

It is Ohio EPA's understanding that the facility will install a new hazardous waste tank in 2009. Once the new tank is installed, please submit a copy of the tank assessment certification documents in accordance with OAC rules 3745-66-90 through 66-100.
