Dear Mr. Jackett:

On December 17, 2009, Ohio EPA's Division of Hazardous Waste Management, represented by Edward D'Amato and John Palmer, conducted an inspection at Tartan and C&C Yachts. The purpose of the inspection was to follow up to Ohio EPA's previous inspections on June 16, 2009 and August 6, 2009. Bud Gorman and Bill Ross represented Tartan and C&C yachts during the inspection.

It appears that Tartan and C&C Yachts has made considerable progress in identifying and disposing of the waste materials in the approximately 126 containers that were identified during the previous inspections. Approximately 4 containers remain. Copies of disposal records for 14 drums of acetone were provided to Ohio EPA during the inspection.

No later than January 31, 2010, Tartan and C&C Yachts must complete the identification and disposal process for the remaining containers and submit a complete, written report identifying the contents of each of the containers and documenting the disposal process.

The following violation, cited in Ohio EPA's June 16, 2009 Notice of Violation, remains outstanding until identification and disposal activities have been completed and the written report submitted to this office:

1. **Hazardous Waste Determination**  
**OAC 3745-52-11**

*Any person who generates a waste in the state of Ohio...shall determine if the waste is a listed hazardous waste...*

Failure to list specific deficiencies in this communication does not relieve Tartan/C&C Yachts or Grand River Investments from the responsibility of complying with all applicable Ohio EPA laws and regulations. Please be advised that present or past instances of non-compliance can continue as subjects of pending or future enforcement actions.
