Dear Mr. Kozak:

On February 2, 2009, Ohio EPA received a response to our fourth NOV letter dated December 8, 2008. You were requested to provide analytical data evaluating a potential D007 waste from chromatating tanks T1, T2, T3, T4 and T5 of Barrel Line #1 and chromatating tanks T4 and T5 of Barrel Line #2.

It is understood from your response that you have recently instituted weekly dumps of this waste to your waste water treatment system such that no sludge residues that might require separate handling, are generated.

In addition, you provided a Bill of Lading for sludge waste sent offsite in June 2008 and completed inspection checklists for emergency equipment. Review of all information submitted, including the closure performance documentation received on July 28, 2008, indicates that you appear to have abated all violations cited in my letters including:

OAC 3745-52-11, Waste Evaluation,
OAC 3745-65-32 (A)(B)(C), Required Equipment,
OAC 3745-65-33, Testing and Maintenance of Equipment and,
ORC 3734.02(E) and (F).

Please keep in mind that all hazardous wastes going to your waste water treatment system must be managed as a hazardous waste until treated in the system. That is, they must be labeled, dated, kept closed and tracked as a hazardous waste.
