Dear Mr. Garver:

A Progress Report summary was received on June 29, 2010. The summary documented waste disposed and materials recycled between August 2009 and June 2010.

All violations of Ohio's hazardous waste regulations appear to have been abated including:

- 1) Waste Evaluation, OAC 3745-52-11.

CONCERN

You must continue to evaluate and remove from the remaining stored materials all wastes and *maintain documentation* of the wastes accumulated and those sent off site for disposal or recycling. You must also continue to identify and manage universal waste lamps, batteries or mercury containing devices as a universal waste and remove tires, solid wastes and other debris. Properly dispose all items that are determined to be a hazardous waste, universal waste or regulated substance.
