Dear Mr. Fargo:

I have received your May 30, 2008 letter which responded to my May 2, 2008 letter. As outlined below, Fargo Machine has corrected all the violations and addressed all the concerns found during my April 22, 2008 inspection of Fargo Machine located at 998 Stevenson Road, Ashtabula, Ohio.

You provided an invoice and MSDS for Starblast which my letter referred to as industrial slag. You also stated that you have determined that the used Starblast now stored at your facility is not a hazardous waste. Based on the MSDS and my understanding of your cutting process, this determination appears to be reasonable. Therefore, your plan to store it before recycling it is allowed by the hazardous waste rules.

1. OAC rule 3745-52-11 – Hazardous waste determination.
Your letter described how used fluorescent lamps will be saved. We also spoke on the phone on June 13, 2008. You stated you will ensure that the used lamps will be recycled and will keep paperwork showing that. This shows that Fargo Machine has corrected this violation.

Your letter describes how any liquid waste generated from painting cleanup will be managed. This shows that Fargo Machine has addressed this concern.


2. OAC rule 3745-279-22(C) - Used oil labels.
