**RE: FERRO CORPORATION, COLOR AND GLASS PERFORMANCE MATERIALS,
LARGE QUANTITY GENERATOR OHD 049 369 440, WAYNE COUNTY,
NOTICE OF VIOLATION / RETURN TO COMPLIANCE**

Dear Mr. Reagan:

On June 19, 2008, Ohio EPA conducted a Compliance Evaluation Inspection of Ferro Corporation located at 1560 North Main Street, Orrville, Ohio. The purpose of the inspection was to determine Ferro's compliance with Ohio's hazardous waste laws as found in Chapter 3734 of the Ohio Revised Code (ORC), and Chapter 3745 of the Ohio Administrative Code (OAC). Ohio EPA was represented by Kris Coder and me. Ferro Corporation was represented by you.

Ferro Corporation was inspected for the following requirements: a Large Quantity Generator of Hazardous Waste; a Used Oil generator and a Small Quantity Handler of Universal Waste. Enclosed is a copy of the inspection checklists pertaining to these requirements. A full discussion of the facility's processes, waste management units and pollution prevention (P2) activities, as understood by Ohio EPA, is provided in the "Process Description/Waste Activities Summary" section of the checklist.

Based on this inspection, Ohio EPA found Ferro Corporation in violation of the following rule:

1. OAC Rule 3745-52-34(A)(2)- Container Dates.

While inspecting the hazardous waste storage area we noticed that one of the containers was improperly dated.

The issue was abated during the inspection by Mr. Reagan placing a correct date on the label.
