Dear Ms. Gallagher:

On March 6, 2007, I received Lexington Connector Seals' (LCS) response to Ohio EPA's January 25, 2007 Notice of Violation/Partial Return to Compliance (NOV/PRTC) letter. Subsequently, on April 5, 2007, I received your response containing the analytical results for the waste generated from clean-up activities at the mold cleaning area.

The following is the status of the previously identified, unabated violation:

- OAC rule 3745-65-31, Maintenance and Operation:** During the January 16, 2007 inspection, Ohio EPA observed caustic liquid ($\text{pH} \geq 13$) in the drip pan beneath the mold cleaning vat. Additionally, evidence of caustic staining was observed on the concrete beneath the mold cleaning vat, as well as around the drip pan. LCS's March 6 response provided information concerning the corrective actions taken to address the liquid and staining. **Based upon submitted documentation, LCS has adequately abated this violation. No further response to this violation is required.**

Ohio EPA's failure to list specific deficiencies or violations in this letter does not relieve LCS from having to comply with all applicable regulations.
