This letter acknowledges receipt on June 14, 2011, of your correspondence dated June 13, 2011. That correspondence responded to Ohio EPA's NOV letter dated May 9, 2011.

My review of the documentation provided by this correspondence, which included: annual personnel training documentation and documentation of shipment of used lamps, indicates that Lite Metals has adequately demonstrated abatement of the following violations from the April 21, 2011 inspection cited in my letter of May 9, 2011, specifically:

1. **OAC 3745-273-273-15(A) Small quantity handler may only accumulate for one year unless additional accumulation time is necessary to facilitate proper recovery treatment or disposal.**
2. **OAC Rule 3745-65-16 (C) Personnel Must Take Part In An Annual Review Of The Initial Training.**
