SEVENTH NOTICE OF VIOLATION

Dear Mr. Hill:

JR's Trucks and Parts has not demonstrated the correction of all the violations found during my May 31, 2005 inspection. Below I will outline the current status of these violations and explain what you need to do to correct them and to demonstrate that correction.

1. OAC rule 3745-279-22(B) - Condition of used oil storage units. Previously corrected.
2. OAC 3745-279-22(C) - Used oil labels. When we last spoke on December 4, 2006, you said that the new used oil tank was not yet in service but would be soon. **Send me documentation showing that this tank has been labeled as used oil.**
3. OAC 3745-279-22(D) - Response to releases of used oil. During my inspections of JR's Trucks since my June 8, 2006 letter, I have seen that you have removed used oil contaminated soil. You have also sent me manifests showing that four loads of this contaminated soil went to American Landfill, Inc. in Waynesburg, Ohio. This documents your correction of this violation.
4. OAC rule 3745-279-22(B) - Condition of used oil storage units. (Violation found during November 1, 2005 inspection.) OAC 3745-279-22(B) requires that containers and above ground tanks used to store used oil must be in good condition and not leaking.


When we last spoke on December 4, 2006, you said that the new used oil tank was not yet in service but would be soon. **Send me documentation showing that this tank is in good condition and not leaking.**
