Dear Mr. Hill:

On April 12, 2007, Ed D'Amato and I met with you and Guy at JR's Trucks located at 16606 S. Waterloo Road, in Cleveland, Ohio. The purpose of this was to follow up regarding violations found during my May 31, 2005 inspection. Below I will outline the current status of these violations and explain what action you need to take.

1. OAC rule 3745-279-22(B) - Condition of used oil storage units. Previously corrected.
2. OAC 3745-279-22(C) - Used oil labels. We saw that the two new used oil tanks were labeled as used oil. However, we also saw that the two drums used to accumulate used oil until it is poured into the tanks were not labeled as used oil. **You must label these drums as used oil and send documentation of that to me.**
3. OAC 3745-279-22(D) - Response to releases of used oil. Previously corrected. However, we did see an area of used oil spilled on the concrete pad you now use to cut and drain equipment on. You stated you will put down adsorbant material to soak up this oil. **You must send me documentation showing that this has been done.** There may also have been other areas of used oil spillage, but with the recent rain they could not be seen.
4. OAC rule 3745-279-22(B) - Condition of used oil storage units. (Violation found during November 1, 2005 inspection.) The new used oil tanks were seen to be in good condition and not leaking. At least, one of the funnels in the fill pipes was open. This should be kept closed so that you are not forced to ship rainwater offsite along with your used oil. The old used oil tank still has used oil in it. It is also not in good condition. Specifically, if it is filled much past its current level, the used oil will start to leak out the sidehatch. You stated that the used oil in this old tank will be shipped offsite and the tank will be cut up for scrap metal. **You must send me documentation showing that this has been done.**
