Dear Mr. Goody:

On April 10, 2012, I performed a compliance inspection of your company to determine its compliance with Ohio's hazardous waste laws and regulations as found in Chapter 3734 of the Ohio Revised Code (ORC) and Chapter 3745 of the Ohio Administrative Code (OAC).

Based on our observations and review of your facility documentation, during this inspection, we found the following violation of the hazardous waste regulations:

- (1) **Used oil storage requirements for generators, OAC rule 3745-279-22(C):**
Paragraph (C): Containers and aboveground tanks used to store used oil at generator facilities shall be marked clearly with the words "Used Oil."

During the inspection, we observed that your two used oil tanks (a 200 gallon tank inside and a 1000 gallon tank in front of the shop) were not labeled "Used Oil". You marked these tanks appropriately during the inspection, therefore, you have returned to compliance with this regulation.

You abated all violations cited during the April 10, 2012 inspection. I have included the checklists I used to evaluate your facility and a factsheet on used oil with this letter for your use. I have also included a factsheet on Spill Prevention Control and Countermeasure (SPCC) regulations which may apply to your facility.
