Dear Resident:

I am writing this letter in response to a complaint received by this office March 30, 2012. The complaint alleges that you burn trash, plastics and garbage at your home.

On April 5, 2012, I investigated this complaint. Evidence of the open burning of trash and other solid waste materials was observed in a brick fire ring in the backyard. I attempted to speak to you, but you were not home at the time of my investigation. I left a pamphlet in your door that explains Ohio's open burning rules.

Garbage, trash and plastics cannot be open burned anywhere in Ohio.

To open burn residential waste such as paper, leaves, tree trimmings, cardboard, etc., the property must be located in an unrestricted area (as this property is) and the burn site must be at least 1,000 feet from any inhabited building not on the property. Because there is not a burn site location on the property that is at least 1,000 feet from any inhabited building not on the property, you cannot open burn residential waste at this location.

Open burning of improper waste materials at this location is in violation of Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) rule 3745-19-04 and is punishable by a fine. All open burning in violation of the requirements specified in OAC rule 3745-19-04 must stop immediately. If you continue to open burn improper waste materials at this location or any other location in Ohio, legal action may be taken against you.
