RE: Failure to comply with the April 9, 2007 Director's Findings and Orders

Dear Mayor Smith:

The April 9, 2007 Director's Findings and Orders (April 9, 2007 DFFOs), required the Village of Salineville to complete the following Supplemental Environmental Project (SEP) in Order No. 20:

*"In lieu of implementing the \$5,000.00 SEP agreed upon in the Director's Findings and Orders, issued July 22, 2005 (Finding #39), Respondent shall implement a SEP consisting of the following:*

- a. Within ninety (90) days of the effective date of these Orders, the Respondent shall inspect and repair or replace the raw water valves from both the reservoir and the creek so that the raw water source can be isolated as needed; and*
- b. Within ninety (90) days of the effective date of these Orders, the Respondent shall install telemetry to accurately determine the water level in the finished water reservoir."*

I have included a copy of the April 9, 2007 DFFOs with this letter. To date, Ohio EPA has not received any documentation that telemetry has been installed on the finished water reservoir (Order No. 20b). Since the Village has failed to complete the SEP, payment of the civil penalty is due immediately. Payment shall be made in the amount of five thousand dollars (\$5,000.00) by official check made payable to "Treasurer, State of Ohio". The official check shall be submitted to Akia Smith, together with a letter identifying the Village of Salineville, at:

Should the Village fail to either install the telemetry or pay the \$5,000 civil penalty by May 1, 2012, Ohio EPA will evaluate the necessity for further enforcement. If you have any additional questions regarding this matter, you may contact me at (614) 644-2752.
