Dear Ms. Hoover:

In a letter dated April 2, 2012, Ohio EPA provided notice of violations occurring at Fairmount Memorial Park, (Property) located at 4199 S. Union Avenue, in Alliance, Stark County Ohio. The violations were originally communicated to you during a telephone conversation following the inspection conducted on March 15, 2012. Ohio EPA received a correspondence, dated April 13, 2012, from Fairmount Memorial Park that documents abatement of the following violations:
