Thank you for your response letter received March 13, 2007, to Ohio EPA's Notice of Violation letter dated February 15, 2007. Your submittal included a revised checklist that included emergency spill response equipment. The following Division of Hazardous Waste violations have been abated:

- 1) OAC 3745-65-33, Testing and Maintenance of Equipment
- 2) OAC 3745-52-34(C)(1)(b), Accumulation Requirements

CONCERN RESPONSE

Through phone conversation and email response with you on March 16, 2007, several identified concerns are being addressed as follows:

- Universal wastes accumulated onsite are scheduled for shipment. Future universal waste accumulation will be dated and time tracked.
- The interior storm (floor) drain located near the indoor 90-day hazardous waste storage room area is scheduled to be bermed.
- RCRA empty aerosol cans can be disposed as solid waste. Cans that do not empty will be collected in a satellite container for waste evaluation.
