**WARNING LETTER**

Dear Mr. Pridemore:

Pursuant to Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) rule and Clark County Combined Health District Air Pollution Control Regulations (CCCHDAPCR) section 3745-21-09 (DDD)(2), the stage II vapor control system at the Springfield Food Mart gasoline dispensing facility (GDF) located at 936 W. North St., in Springfield, Ohio, must perform and successfully pass the testing requirements contained in OAC rule 3745-21-10. In accordance with the yearly static pressure drop decay testing requirement specified in CARB Executive Order G-70-154-AA and the Static Leak Test contained in OAC rule 3745-21-10, Appendix A, Static Leak testing and Air to Liquid Ratio (A/L) testing shall be successfully conducted at least once in each twelve consecutive month period after the date of successful completion of the startup or most recent Static Leak Test.

OAC rule and CCCHDAPCR section 3745-21-09(DDD)(1) state: "no owner or operator of a gasoline dispensing facility may cause, allow or permit the transfer of gasoline from a stationary storage tank at a GDF into a motor vehicle . . . unless the following requirements are met: . . . (c)The vapor control system has successfully passed the testing requirements contained in paragraph (DDD)(2) of this rule." This GDF is required to demonstrate compliance on an annual basis and was issued a Board of Health Order on October 5, 2006 stating that an annual compliance test must be scheduled within thirty (30) days. Springfield Food Mart is currently operating in violation of OAC rule and CCCHDAPCR section 3745-21-09 (DDD)(2) and the prohibitions in Ohio Revised Code (ORC) section 3704.05.

This letter serves as a warning from the Regional Air Pollution Control Agency (RAPCA) to

cease operation in violation of OAC rule and CCCHDAPCR section 3745-21-09 (DDD)(2) and ORC section 3704.05. It is imperative that Springfield Food Mart schedule and show compliance with stage II testing requirements. **Please respond, in writing, to this notice within fourteen (14) days after receipt of this letter. The response will specify the intended test date.** Your tester should contact Casie Lord, at (937) 225-5939, to ensure a RAPCA representative is present at your scheduled testing.
