Dear Mr. Rollins:

On June 23, 2010, Mr. Mike Sherron of the Ohio EPA, Southeast District Office, Division of Emergency and Remedial Response, observed a tire fire on State Route 93 near Gore. Upon investigation, he found that you were open burning several tires found during a cleanup of your property. After being notified that it is illegal to open burn tires, you extinguished the fire.

Tires cannot be open burned in Ohio. Open burning of improper waste materials at this location is in violation of Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) rule 3745-19-04 and is punishable by a fine. I am enclosing a pamphlet that explains Ohio's open burning rules. If you continue to open burn improper waste materials, legal action will be taken against you
