Dear Mr. Danner:

I am writing this letter in response to a complaint received by this office on January 26, 2009. The complaint alleges that plastic-coated copper wire was open burned at your business on Hunters Woods Road, Logan.

On February 11, 2009, I investigated this complaint and spoke to you. Evidence of open burning was observed in two locations. The first was behind your building. It appeared that paper, cardboard and a small motor had been burned at this location. The second area where I observed evidence of open burning was close to your tool shed. There were some small pieces of wire and paper burned at this location. You told me that you had open burned to unfreeze the door on your shed.

As I explained during my visit, plastics, copper wire, or any type of waste materials associated with your recycling business cannot be open burned. Open burning of this type is in violation of Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) rule 3745-19-04 and is punishable by a fine. I gave you a pamphlet that explains Ohio's open burning rules when I spoke to you. If you continue to open burn improper waste materials, legal action may be taken against you.
