Dear Mr. Glasspoole:

On June 30, 2011, Mr. Mike Sherron observed you burning furniture on State Route 180, Laurelville. He informed you that this type of burning is not permitted in Ohio and the fire needed to be put out.

Furniture, plastics, tires, garbage, demolition wastes, as well as other waste materials cannot be open burned in Ohio. Open burning of improper waste materials at this location is in violation of Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) rule 3745-19-04 and is punishable by a fine. I am enclosing a pamphlet that explains this rule for you. All open burning in violation of the requirements specified in OAC rule 3745-19-04 must stop immediately. If the open burning of waste materials occurs again, legal action will be taken.
