WARNING LETTER

Dear Mr. Matthews:

On July 28, 2011, the Regional Air Pollution Control Agency (RAPCA) received a complaint from a local citizen regarding open burning originating from your property at 2424 Pinegrove Dr., Dayton, OH. On July 29, 2011, RAPCA performed an inspection at 2424 Pinegrove and documented evidence of open burning at the rear of your property near the fence line.

Open burning for waste disposal in a restricted area is a violation of Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) and Montgomery County Combined General Health District Air Pollution Control Regulations (MCCGHDAPCR) 3745-19-03. A restricted area is an area within the boundary of any municipal corporation, plus a zone extending one mile beyond any such municipal corporation.

This letter serves as a warning from the Regional Air Pollution Control Agency to cease all open burning in violation of both state and local air pollution control regulations. In the future, alternative means of disposal must be employed. Any future illegal burning may result in enforcement action which may include civil and criminal penalties.
