Failure to Submit Required Quarterly Reports for Emissions Units P001 and P019

Dear Mr. Wilson,

WARNING LETTER

The Regional Air Pollution Control Agency (RAPCA) has recently reviewed our files to determine whether permitted facilities are in compliance with the reporting requirements identified in their permit terms and conditions. Upon review of the facility files, RAPCA identified that A.P.S. Materials, Inc. (APS) has not submitted all required quarterly reports for emissions units (EUs) P001 (Thermal Spraying Biomed #3 with Baghouse) and P019 (Muriatic Acid Etching Tank with Scrubber).

Specifically, pursuant to part II.D.1 of Permit-to-Install (PTI) 08-2750, issued August 18, 1993, and the Permit-to-Operate (PTO) issued September 6, 2002, for EU P001, APS is required to submit quarterly deviation reports that identify all periods of time during which the pressure drop across the baghouse did not comply with the allowable range of 1-5 inches of water.

Additionally, Pursuant to part II.D.1 of PTI 08-04659, modified February 5, 2008, and the PTO issued March 6, 2008, for EU P019, APS is required to submit quarterly deviation reports that identify all periods of time during which the following scrubber parameters were not maintained at the required levels specified in section B of the permits:

- a. The static pressure drop across the scrubber.
- b. The scrubber water flow rate.
- c. The pH of the scrubber liquor.

APS did not submit any required quarterly reports for EUs P001 and P019 for the calendar year of 2009 and the first quarter of 2010. If no deviations of permit terms and conditions occur during a reporting period, a report stating such must be submitted to satisfy the quarterly reporting requirements. The required information may be combined into one deviation report for both EU P001 and EU P019. Quarterly reports must be submitted by April 30 (1st quarter), July 31 (2nd quarter), October 31 (3rd quarter), and January 31 (4th quarter), of each year covering operations during the previous calendar quarter. **Failure to submit quarterly deviation reports is a violation of PTI 08-2750, PTI 08-04659, the PTOs and ORC 3704.05.**

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A.P.S. Materials, Inc.
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At this time, RAPCA requires that APS submit all past due quarterly deviation reports for EUs P001 and P019 for the first through fourth quarters of 2009 and the first quarter of 2010. These reports must be submitted within 14 days of receipt of this letter
