WARNING LETTER

Dear Resident:

On June 5, 2007, the Regional Air Pollution Control Agency (RAPCA), received a complaint regarding illegal open burning of trash at 7225 W. Frederick Garland Rd, West Milton, Ohio. That same day RAPCA inspected the premises and found a recreational burn site and a burn barrel located in the rear of the property. The burn barrel was located within 1,000 feet of the nearest neighboring residence. On June 11, 2007, RAPCA received a second complaint stating that carpet and other miscellaneous waste items had been burned in the burn barrel on June 10, 2007.

Pursuant to Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) rule and Miami County Board of Health Local Air Pollution Control Regulations (MCBHLAPCR) 3745-19-04, Open burning in unrestricted areas, open burning for waste disposal purposes within 1,000 of the nearest neighboring inhabited residence is prohibited. Additionally, no waste containing rubber, grease, asphalt or liquid petroleum products, such as plastics and furniture, for the purposes of waste disposal is permitted. Therefore, the burn barrel (used for the purposes of burning for waste disposal) observed on June 5, 2007 is a violation of OAC and MCBHLAPCR rule 3745-19-04.

The above-cited regulations do, however, permit cooking and recreational fires. Such fires are required to be fueled with clean seasoned firewood, may not be used for waste disposal purposes, and must have a total fuel area of three feet or less in diameter and two feet or less in height. A recreational fire fueled with material other than clean seasoned firewood within one thousand feet of a neighboring residence is a violation of the open burning regulations.

This letter serves as notification to you of the above mentioned violation. Any further actions in violation of the above mentioned rules may result in an enforcement action with civil and/or criminal penalties. If you have any questions, please contact me at 937-225-4004.
