Dear Mr. Burgefurd:

This letter is written regarding a storm water inspection conducted by Abigail Tamkin and Megan Reising of the Ohio EPA at the Radnor Road Bridge over the Scioto River located near the intersection of Radnor Road and State Route 257 in Radnor, Ohio on August 26, 2010. The purpose of the inspection was to evaluate compliance with the General Storm Water Permit Associated with Construction Activities. During the inspection, our staff noted the following issues associated with construction activities at this site:

Sediment and Erosion Control:

- At the time of the inspection, there were no sediment controls in place at the site. Construction had started and barren earth was apparent on both banks of the river. Controls will need to be installed within three days of receipt of this letter.
- The stream crossing appeared to be constructed properly, of non-erodible fill.
