Dear Mr. Greenblott:

This letter is written in regard to the storm water inspection that I conducted at G-Cor Automotive Corporation, located at 2100 Refugee Road, in Columbus, Ohio. The inspection was conducted on January 25, 2010, to determine compliance with your industrial storm water permit. You stated that you company recycles automotive parts from vehicles. I did not note any discharges from your facility to a storm water drain or waters of the state.

The following items were noted during the inspection:

1. The empty drums stored outside should be closed with a lid and stored upright. Some drums were spilling product on to the ground. Please see attached pictures.
2. The ash from the boiler was stored outside and uncovered. You stated that this waste was hauled away several times per week. It is recommended that this waste be stored under roof or cover if it will not be stored for more than one week. Please see attached picture.
3. A few puddles had an oily sheen. Please ensure that oil absorbent and house-keeping measures prevent excessive oil from getting on to the ground. Please see attached picture.


