This letter is regarding the storm water inspection that I conducted on December 23, 2009, at the Eichhorn Street project located along Diley Road, north of Kings Crossing. The Agency understands that these construction activities are currently covered under the General Storm Water Permit Associated with Construction Activities. It appeared during the inspection that construction activity has been completed for this site and all disturbed areas had been permanently stabilized. Please address the following:

Post Construction Requirements:

The General Permit mandates specific water quality treatment for storm water following the completion of construction (see attachment). Please be able to demonstrate your post construction requirements per the General Permit will be met. Please submit to my attention the water quality calculations demonstrating compliance. This information can be sent to my attention via a response letter, or to my email at greg.sanders@epa.state.oh.us.
